Pervez Musharraf gives new strength to terrorism

Statement issued by Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi, BJP General Secretary & Spokesman

T HE General Secretary and spokesman of the BJP, Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi has said that by trying to legitimize religious extremism and fundamentalism through election in Pakistan, Parvez Musharraf has given a new strength to the terrorism.

The world has to realise that no campaign, however concerted it could be, will be successful unless the very nerve centre of terrorism and its sponsors and supporters are dealt with sternly. This is a common knowledge that the most - dreaded terrorist outfit Al - Quida has its base in Pakistan and its hand in the terrorist action in Bali is being talked about. All peace loving nations have to take serious note of this

inhuman act of terrorists and pool in their resources to eradicate this menace from the face of the world.

The selection of Bali Island, which is a famous centre of Hindu religion and culture, attracting millions of tourists across the world, is very significant. Through this massacre of innocents the religious extremists want to send the message about their ominous presence in the country which has the highest muslim population in the world. The tentacles of terrorists are expanding in so-far peaceful parts of the world and no nation should feel itself fully insulated from such mindless and inhuman acts.

Mr Naqvi said that as long as

Pakistan would be in control of anti democratic forces, no campaign against terrorism would bring in any results. The extremists in garb of politicians should not be allowed to carry on the agenda of religious extremists and the government there should work for world-peace and people's welfare.

The time has come that the west should rescind its double standards on terrorism and evolve an all-pervading policy on terrorism.

Mr Naqvi said no one had been surprised by Parvez Mussarraff questioning about J&K elections as no autocrat and anti democratic ruler has the authority or wisdom to assess a democratic process.
